FINDING THE RIGHT COURSE

OFFICIAL EXAMINATION CENTRE - CERTIFICATIONS & DIPLOMAS

Alliance Française Halifax is an official examination centre for several French diplomas and certificates.

Each assesses the candidate's level in speaking, writing, listening and reading.

The rating systems of these tests and diplomas are based on the Common European Framework for Languages.

- **DELF & DALF** (Diplôme d'Etudes en Langue Française and Diplôme Approfondi en Langue Française) are official diplomas awarded by the French Department of Education to certify a non-native speaker's competence in general French. A junior version of DELF is also available to secondary-school students.
- **TCF** (*Test de Connaissance du Français*) assesses candidates' level in French for general purposes. It is intended for people who are not native French speakers who, for professional, personal or academic reasons, want to have their competency in French certified simply and reliably. Often required for Canadian students applying to study in French universities.
- **TEF** (*Test d'Evaluation du Français*) is a comprehensive language placement test for non-native French speakers who wish to obtain a quick and precise snapshot of their general language skills for professional or personal reasons (such as immigration to Canada or studies in France). It is also recognized by Citizenship and Immigration Canada.
- **DAEFLE** (Diplôme d'Aptitude à l'Enseignement du Français Langue Etrangère) is a diploma provided by the Alliance Française de Paris and the CNED (Centre National d'Enseignement à Distance). This diploma is designed for professors and those who intend to become teachers.
