The safety of our students is our priority. With respect to Ontario Public Health regulation, we made the decision to close our facility on March 16, 2020. It does not mean that we have cancelled our courses. They have been offered online since that date to keep safe our students.

- The <u>adult group classes</u> have also migrated to online courses. With the help of the Alliance Française network, we prepared an online teaching plan allowing continuity of all our courses. This practice has been in effect at the AFO since March 21 with excellent results.

<u>The next session "Spring 2</u>" will start May 13, 2020. In case of continuity of health crisis related to COVID-19, all our courses will remain online for this session as well until further notice.
